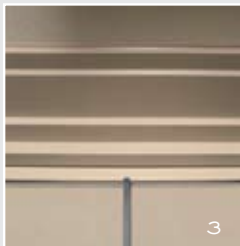
INTERIOR DECOR SPECIALIST INTRODUCES

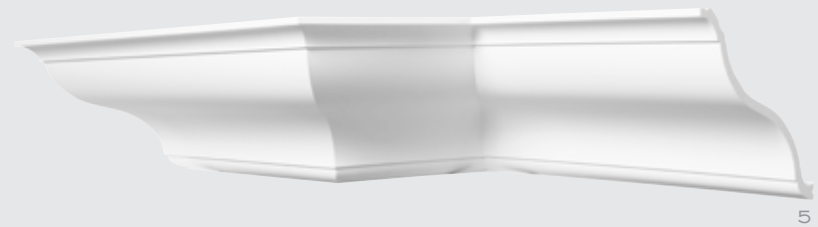
There are three sub brands within the umbrella ORAC DÉCOR brand: ORAC LUXXUS, ORAC AXXENT and ORAC BASIXX. ORAC LUXXUS has been positioned differently. It is an exclusive range of creative mouldings and decorative accessories with a strong visual impact. The various mouldings are made from high-quality polymers such as Duropolymer[®] and Purotouch[®]. ORAC LUXXUS also includes a complete range of innovative indirect lighting. ORAC AXXENT consists of professional cornices, dado rails and skirting boards made from Duropolymer[®] which are intricately detailed to add a unique touch to your home. The standard range ORAC BASIXX consists of functional to slightly decorative Durofoam[®] cornices.

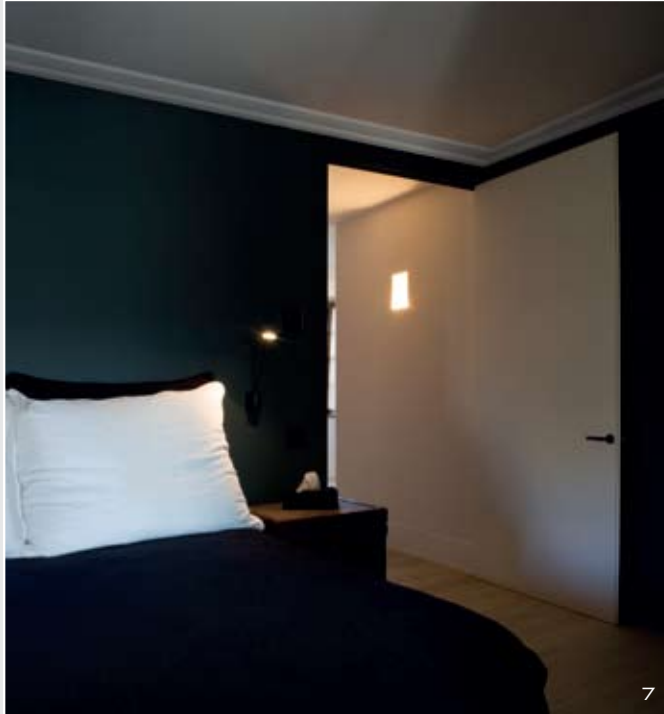


NEW: XL COLLECTION

The XL collection is totally new to the ORAC LUXXUS range. It consists of seven extra large mouldings: three cornices, three dado rails and a skirting board with large height. Architect Xavier Donck designed the monumental mouldings that have now made ORAC DECOR's collection totally complete. The collection was designed primarily for tall houses but gives creative decorators room for manoeuvre because you can place the mouldings both horizontally and vertically, depending on the desired result.

Xavier Donck: "Mouldings really add to your interior. They can help give your house a soul. The XL collection has a powerful visual effect. The cornice is what is called a 'gorge', and reminds me of old country houses in France from the 17th and 18th century who have withstood the test of time, retaining their character. You can combine an asymmetrical gorge with a stair skirting or a so-called Napoleon's hat, or you could place it on the ceiling length or width ways. Nothing creates a cosy atmosphere like a high skirting board. It breaks up the bare transition from wall to floor and gives a cold cube warmth. It is simply indispensable."
